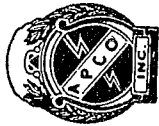

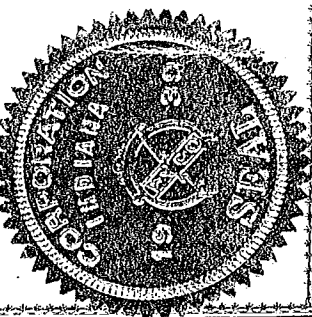


CHARTER THE NORTHWEST CHAPTER

Whereas, R. G. Quantz, Clarence Williams, W. A. Gebenini
all residents of the State of Washington, have filed their application in writing with the Associated Police Communication Officers, Incorporated in the Office of the Secretary-Treasurer as required by Article 1, Section 3, (Amended) of the Constitution, for authority to organize a Chapter under the name THE NORTHWEST CHAPTER, ASSOCIATED POLICE COMMUNICATION OFFICERS, Incorporated, to be located at a place within the State of Washington. The said NORTHWEST CHAPTER has in all respects complied with all requirements of the Constitution and By-Laws governing the formation of same.

Now Therefore, I, Eric Erickson, Secretary-Treasurer of the Associated Police Communication Officers, Incorporated, and acting under the direction of Frank W. Walker, President, in virtue and by authority of Article 1, Section 3, (Amended) of the Constitution, do hereby certify that said parties, their associates and successors have become a Body, duly organized under the name, THE NORTHWEST CHAPTER, ASSOCIATED POLICE COMMUNICATION OFFICERS, Incorporated, located at a place within the State of WASHINGTON and shall have all the rights and privileges granted to State or Regional Chapters under the Constitution.
